



Biathlon competitive program

What is it?

This is a training program that addresses our members who wish to participate in the competitive aspect of biathlon. The competitions are compressed air and / or small bore (.22LR).

We are talking about two competition circuits:

- ✚ Quebec Cup. Consists of a series of six races in the various Biathlon centers located in Quebec (Gatineau, Estrie, Mauricie, Laurentides, Québec, etc.).
- ✚ The Cadet movement has its own race circuit in the different regions it serves, including the regional, provincial and national level.


Who is it for?

Youth, boys and girls aged from 12 years old and over can join this program. However, they must meet one of the two prerequisite:

- ✚ Bears program is completed;
- ✚ They belong to the Biathlon Team of their cadet unit.

The athletes may be invited to participate at training camps in various Biathlon High performance training centres of Quebec (Gatineau, Laurentides, Québec, Estrie, Mauricie, etc...)

Note:

- ✚ The meeting place of participants takes place at the shooting range. About 50 meters from the Chalet (behind the garage). Unless otherwise indicated.
- ✚ It is suggested to arrive 20 minutes early to prepare.
- ✚ Allow time, if you think you need to wax at skis site.

How much is it?

The Annual Membership Fees are 35\$ and includes:

- Biathlon Canada registration
- Biathlon Quebec registration
- CBVS membership registration

The Session cost is per participant:

- Fall season \$150
- Winter season \$150

- ✚ For cadets, arrangements are usually snuff with units who wish to train with the club. Please consult your-coach for more detail.
- ✚ This price includes only the trainings to the Base de Plein-air Les Cèdres and inter-club competitions. All other costs for regional camps, access to ski resorts, regional competitions, provincial and national are the responsibility of the participant.
- ✚ However, the club may, at its discretion and with the approval of its board of directors decide to participate in certain costs, in extra-mural activities.

Note:

A session may be canceled, if the Base de Plein-air Les Cèdres is closed or if the club considers that climatic conditions are such that they pose a risk to the health of the participant. Generally, the club will try to best fit a replacement date, in the same season.

What does the Club provide?

- ✚ Coach
- ✚ Fire range
- ✚ Biathlon air rifle targets (BT-100) and paper targets
- ✚ Air rifles
- ✚ Pellets
- ✚ Bears Program Merit badges

- ✚ Warm clothing (given temperature)
- ✚ Hat and gloves
- ✚ Skis, poles and boots.
